

DIY Degreaser: What to buy and how to make it

Shopping List & Equipment Needed	Using Your Degreaser
☐ 125ml white vinegar	Preparation
☐ 80ml clear household ammonia	☐ Clear area of loose debris
☐ 60ml bicarbonate of soda	☐ Ensure appliances are cool and
☐ 2 tablespoons liquid castile soap	unplugged
☐ 1.5 litres water	Have cleaning cloths ready
☐ Large mixing bowl or jug	Application
☐ Spray bottle (reusable)	☐ Spray generously on greasy surfaces
☐ Funnel	Let sit for 3 to 5 minutes
☐ Measuring cups and spoons	Work surface with sponge in circular motions
☐ Sponge or microfibre cloths	☐ Wipe with clean, damp cloth
Making Your Degreaser	☐ Dry thoroughly with cloth
Step 1: Mix The Base	What You Can Clean
☐ Add water to mixing bowl first	☐ Stovetops and hobs
Slowly pour in white vinegarStir gently	☐ Kitchen cabinets
	Oven and microwave doors and interiors
Chan 2 All Classic Day	☐ Light switches
Step 2: Add Cleaning Power	☐ Door handles
 Gradually sprinkle in bicarbonate of soda while stirring 	☐ Wall marks
☐ Add liquid castile soap slowly	☐ Garage/workshop areas
☐ Let bubbles settle if needed	Cleaning Schedule
Step 3: Final Ingredient	☐ Daily: Wipe cooking surfaces after use
☐ Add clear household ammonia last	☐ Weekly: Clean cabinet fronts, inside the microwave, and the area around the cooker
☐ Ensure good ventilation	
☐ Stir gently to combine	☐ Monthly/Seasonal: Deep clean top of the
Step 4: Store	fridge, behind appliances, inside of the oven
☐ Pour into spray bottle using funnel	Oven
☐ Label bottle clearly	Notes
☐ Store leftover mixture in sealed
